Registration includes a submitted paper topic, the abstract followed by the key words (in mother tongue and English). The abstract should not exceed the 300 word limit and should be sent by electronic mail, until 15th of June, 2013.

The presentation time is 15 minutes (10 minutes for presentation and 5 minutes for discussion).

Forum languages will be: Serbian and all other Slavic languages, English.

The Forum participants pay the registration fee of 30€. The registration fee includes: a book of abstracts, a certificate of participation, a publication of Forum papers. Master students and basic level students of Faculty of Arts in Niš are free from registration fee payment.

The **Forum** artistic program will be completed with the promotions of the books of *Dr. Ana Hofman* (ethnomusicologist) and *Aleksandar Serdar, MA* (pianist).

The **Forum** *artistic* part includes:

- the presentation of the opus of composers: prof. Aleksandar S. Vujić, representing Serbia and Prof. Dr. Dimitrije Bužarovski, representing the Republic of Macedonia.

The **Forum** organizer's intention is to present every year artists from two Balkan countries (the host country and one of the participating countries), and thus contribute much to mutual introduction and affirmation of certain Balkan cultures. The Forum will also host a joint exhibition of the artists of the two representing countries.
